About the Alliance

The Famvin Homeless Alliance (FHA) supports established and emerging Vincentian homelessness initiatives across the globe. We take a broad definition of homelessness – encompassing those living on the street, refugees and those displaced from their home, and slum dwellers in inadequate housing.

With a membership of over two million people, there are Vincentian Family homelessness projects across six continents helping hundreds of thousands of people each year. The FHA acts as a bridge for those projects, fostering cross-border learning and supporting their development. The FHA is also helping to create new homelessness projects.

The FHA was set up in 2017 to mark the 400th anniversary of the birth of the Vincentian Charism.
